

Visit the famous Panda Research Centre. Travel to Leshan to view the Grand Buddha and visit Huanglongxi before returning to Chengdu. (B, L, D)

# Day 16 Chengdu to Guilin 07 June 2013

Transfer to the airport to board our flight to Guilin. Upon arrival we visit Mt. Diecai. (B, L, D)

## Day 17 Guilin to Yangshou 08 June 2013

Cruise along the Li River, past tranquil farming and fishing villages and picturesque scenery, to Yangshuo. (B, L, D)
